RE: KATZENBACH v. McCLUNG No. 543, October Term, 1964

Mr. Justice Black in his opinion in this case indicated that a majority of the Court was prepared to hear the case, if the parties desire, immediately following that of Beart of Atlanta Motel. Inc. v. United States et al., No. 515, on October 5th.

Counsel have submitted a joint motion to expedite briefing and oral argument, and the jurisdictional statement was filed today. This motion also provides for the filing of briefs on the merits in type-written form on Friday, October 2d, and expresses the desire that the parties be heard immediately following No. 515, on October 5th.
