Timely

Questions: (1) Whether the Civil Rights Act of 1964, particularly Title II, exceeds the power of the Congress to regulate commerce.

(2) Whether the Act results in a "taking" of property within the meaning of the 5th amendment.

(3) Whether the Act violates the 13th amendment by imposing a "condition of servitude" upon the appant.

This, of course, is the case which was set for argument on Oct. 5, 1964. This memo is simply for the record book.
