Dear Judge:
I seek information on your interpretation of "Illegal". U. S. Officials are seeking illegal aliens yet we hear we have to pay for the education of the children of illegal aliens. Something is drastically wrong in your decision to give alien children a free ride on the backs of us who are also paying agents to find illegal aliens.

My interpretation of illegal means unlawful. The only action necessary is instant deportation of these children and their parents. I find it nothing less than astonishing to read various decisions as to the meaning of "illegal". It is perfectly clear to me that these illegal aliens are favored on one hand and U. S. Customs officials and other law enforcement officials are being paid to seek these aliens on the other.

Some clarification is needed for judges who do not know what illegal means.
