Dear Judge Justice:

As a 44 year old taxpayer of this great United States of America, I felt compelled to write you regarding your recent decision on the Training School for Boys at Gatesville, Texas

My mother, Mrs. John O. Potts of Gatesville has been a resident for the past 50 years and has resided at the same address these many years, 1404 E. Main Street. This residence is on the main street of the city and one bathed with numerous businesses and city lights. You would not call it purely private, but definitely not public.

Twice since your intrusion and decisions affecting the Training School for Boys at Gatesville, my mother has had two attempted entrees into her home by escaped inmates of the School, while she was at home.
