Green, Leon, 1888-1978. Leon Green taught at The University of Texas School of Law (1915-1918, 1921-1926, and 1947-1977) and Yale University (1927-1929). In addition, he served as Dean at the University of North Carolina (1926-1927) and Northwestern University (1929-1947) law schools. Green was a distinguished legal scholar and wrote a number of works which had a profound effect on the course of tort doctrine in the United States.

Scope and Content: The Leon Green Papers include correspondence, literary productions, speeches, printed material, and law school administrative and teaching material. Most of the collection reflects Green's activities as an educator and legal scholar.
